

You'll need: A blank piece of paper and a pencil for everyone playing. You may also want a calculator to confirm points at the end of the game.

How many people can play: 2+ (it's better if the whole family plays)

Age: This game is best suited for kids 12yrs and older

Educational benefits: Literacy, Numeracy, Geography & Strategic Thinking

How to play:

1. Everyone draws up their table (similar to the one below)
2. In the "Letter" column, write in the alphabet from A-Z
3. Starting with the letter A, everyone must write down a *Name, Place Animal, Food and Thing* that begins with the corresponding letter.
4. Once everyone has completed the letter row, everyone reads out their answers. You get a point for every word you've come up with. You do not get a point if someone else has the same word, if you've used the same word twice, if you've made up the word, or if you've left a blank space. Total possible points for each row is five.
5. Continue each row as above.
6. The winner is the person with the most points at the end of the game. Total possible points is 130.

Get creative, have fun and play fair (no phones allowed).
